Assignment Objectives:


- The following assignment will be used to

 - fix issues with the standard setup


Get ready

Finder Preferences

- Click the Desktop to access the Finder
- Go to Finder > Preferences [cmd+,]
- Check and adjust the General and Sidebar menus to the following:





Using the MAC

- Click on the desktop to activate the Finder
- Find the DOCK located on the bottom of the screen
- Hover over the applications in the dock with the cursor
- What are the names of 3 applications you find in the dock?









































Using the MAC cont

Double click on the Macintosh HD




- In the Finder window that opens (along the left side) you will see Favorites and Devices
- Click once on Applications under Favorites
- Explore the four views in this finder window



- Which view is the coolest? Which view do you feel gives you the most information about the applications or items in the window?
- You can now close the Finder window

The dock should now look something like this

Explore Photo Booth


 Open the application Photo Booth (Find it in the Applications Launchpad)

- Photo Booth
- Warning: "This application is fun and addictive. If you find yourself using it for more than 3 or 4 minutes, please step away from the computer. I repeat, please step away from the computer and get back on task!"
- Take a NICE photo of yourself
- Select the best photo from the pictures at the bottom of the program
- Drag the photo to your Desktop for temporary storage
- Rename the photo with your lastname_hour.jpg
- Close Photo Booth [shortcut: CMD Q]

Photo Server access


- Click on the Desktop to access the Finder
- Click Go > Connect to Server [cmd+K]
- Type afp://hsdata/photos
- Type your log-in name and password if required (it probably won't be)
- Locate the new "Photos" icon on your desktop



Digital Hand In

- Double click on the photo server icon from the desktop
 - This is the digital server space that this class will often utilize
- Open the HAND IN folder
- Drag the Photo Booth photo that you just renamed from your desktop to the HAND IN folder (proper hour folder)
- Congratulations, you just digitally turned in your first photograph
- Don't worry, you will see these photos pop up somewhere later in the class!






Student Storage Space

- In the Photos Server, navigate out of the Hand In folder to the Student folder
- Create a NEW FOLDER with your User Name
- What is your user name?
- Carefully drag another copy of the Photo Booth photo that you just renamed from your desktop into your newly created folder.
- How do you think you will use this space in this class?
- Close the Photo server window






Pages or Word? (you decide)


- Open the application Pages (or Word) from the dock
- Start a new Text Document
- Enter your name, hour and date on the top of the document
- Type up your answers using complete sentences
- (see next page for further instructions)

Saving your work


- Please save your document on the desktop (temporarily)
 Name the document appropriately (lastname_hour_description) and click save
- Now drag a COPY to the appropriate Hand In>Hour folder (ask if you need help doing this)



Something to Fix




- Click the Apple in the upper left corner
- Click "Shut Down"
- UNCHECK this box
 - (we DO NOT want to reopen windows when logging back in)



Something else to Fix



- Double Click the Macintosh HD in the upper right corner
- At the top of the screen click View>Show Status Bar
