#### Macro

Photography CLOSE UP. Use the "Macro" settings on the camera and reveal details not often seen

# Nature / Landscapes:

A picture that says something about nature and the landscapes we live in

# Architecture:

Architectural features of buildings and structures are highlighted in this photo assignment

#### Event:

This is a group of photojournalistic pictures that shows a one time event and tell a story about it

## Still Life / Product:

A photo of a subject(s) that you have arranged, much like an advertising type picture Often shot in a studio setting using studio lighting techniques (demo shortly)

# Shadows and Light:

Photographs that play on the contrast between shadows and light

#### Motion:

Capture an image that demonstrates the MOTION of the situation

#### Black and White:

Some images lend themselves well to being portrayed in Black and White Showcase your strongest B&W work here. How creative can you be?

#### Food:

Images of food that make your mouth water

# Open:

You decide.

Come up with a creative photo assignment.

**Prior** to shooting, **must** submit a <u>written</u> or <u>verbal</u> statement describing the assignment for approval.

Some examples of photo themes: Love, Cars, Sports, Stylized, the 5 Senses, etc.

Photos will be used at the end of the class to create a PHOTO portfolio. This is part of the Final Exam for the class.

For each assignment, you should strive to shoot at least **50** photos. Only the best however, will be displayed in galleries and added to your portfolio.
