Photoshop Assignment:

"Photo Retouching"

This tutorial will allow you to work with/on:

- Cropping
- the Clone tool
- Selection tools
- Levels
- Layers

For this assignment you will be working on a photograph taken by one of my former students, Noelle Jacobs. Noelle took a nice photo of an Audi at the Auto Show, but felt there was more that could be done to enhance the photo and make it better.

Your challenge is to help Noelle take the photo from the Before to the After (as seen above).

Outline of Steps:

- 1. Open the Photo Server (edc/photo) HAND_OUT folder
- 2. Drag a **COPY** of the CAR_ORIGINAL.psd onto your

desktop.

- 3. Rename the file CAR_LASTNAME.psd
- 4. Open the file in Photoshop
- 5. Duplicate the background layer (so you have an original) Go to Layer > Duplicate

Layer....and press OK

- 6. Crop 1
- 7. Adjust Levels -
- 8. **Clone** Stamp tool work
- 9. Select and remove the background
- 10. Tint the Windshield (selection and levels)
- 11. Add the following information to the bottom of the photo using the Text tool:

Photo by: Noelle Jacobs

Edited by: Your Name

- 12. Save a Copy of the file as a .JPG
- 13. Turn in the CAR_LASTNAME.JPG to the PHOTO server HAND_IN folder.
- 14. Add a new blog post explaining the project. Be sure to show off the car "Before" and "After" in the post.

The point of this assignment is to learn some basic and somewhat advanced photo editing techniques. You can now apply some of these techniques into your future photo projects.
